MR S O'CONNOR ASKED THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE GREAT BARRIER REEF AND MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND YOUTH AFFAIRS (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the amount of funding expended by the State Government on National Park management (reported separately by location and year) for the last five years?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

Queensland has more than 300 national parks and over 700 other protected areas, State forests and land that are managed by the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) in partnership with First Nations peoples.

QPWS has a planning framework that provides a values-based planning approach to park and forest management, consistent with global best practice.

On-ground, our QPWS rangers work in management units that in many instances, are responsible for several national parks, State forests and reserves, consequently it is not possible to identify funding expended at an individual national park level.

QPWS currently has more than 170 operational management units across the State that are directly responsible for protected area management. For the purpose of the Member's question, funding expended over the last five years is summarised by Branch in the table below. This expenditure includes both operating and capital funding however does not include indirect costs that are expended at a state-wide level.
