Question on Notice No. 706 Asked on 24 June 2022

MR L MILLAR ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the calls for service data and the approved strength for Yeppoon, Emu Park, Lakes Creek, North Rockhampton, Rockhampton and Gracemere police divisions (reported separately by year and police division) for the last five years including year to date?

ANSWER:

This Government has committed to the biggest boost to policing in Queensland in three decades. The 2022/23 record police budget supports the rollout of an additional 2,025 police personnel, including 1,450 sworn officers over five years, from 1 July 2020.

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that of the 1,450 additional police officers to be delivered over five years from 1 July 2020, the Police Commissioner has determined that at least 150 positions will be located in the Central Police Region, which includes the Capricornia Police District.

The allocation of police resources is a matter for the Commissioner of Police based on operational policing demand and direct service delivery requirements to ensure a fair and equitable service is provided throughout the State. I am advised these requirements can change as new policing issues emerge.

While the requested information is set out below, it is important to note that <u>in addition</u> to these station/division numbers there are also a number of police personnel who perform district and central police functions such as the Criminal Investigation Branch, Child Protection Investigation Unit, Intelligence, Road Policing and Scenes of Crime who are hosted in particular police stations/divisions.

The approved strength of police personnel for the requested police divisions is detailed in the table below.
