**MR M HART** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND HOUSING, MINISTER FOR DIGITAL ECONOMY AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

# QUESTION:

With reference to social rental properties and bedrooms— Will the Minister advise (a) how many social rental properties and bedrooms (reported separately) are located within the Burleigh Electorate and (b) when was the last social rental property in the Burleigh Electorate constructed?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The total number of social housing dwellings in the Burleigh State Electorate as at 30 June 2022 is 736 which have a combined total of 1376 bedrooms.

Between 2012/13 and 2014/15, only 83 dwellings were delivered in the Gold Coast Region. For the period 2015/16 and 2021/22, the Queensland Government delivered 346 dwellings in the Gold Coast Region.

QuickStarts Queensland will see 260 new social homes commenced in the Gold Coast region by 30 June 2025, supporting more than 225 full-time equivalent jobs.

As at 30 June 2022, under QuickStarts Qld, contracts have been awarded for the commencement of 127 new homes in the Gold Coast Region. Of these 12 are in the Burleigh State Electorate.

The last project constructed in the Burleigh State Electorate was completed in May 2018.

As new public housing opportunities are discovered within the Burleigh State Electorate, these will be assessed and included in the program where appropriate.
