QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise when works will begin on the Kangaroo Point Riverwalk?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for South Brisbane for the question.

In 2020, the Queensland Government committed \$22.5 million to fill in gaps on the popular Riverwalk at Kangaroo Point to create an unbroken bike and pedestrian path linking Kangaroo Point and Mowbray Park.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads and Brisbane City Council (BCC) have commenced a joint study to develop options and concept designs for the path. The study, led by BCC, will also look to provide a connection from the proposed Riverwalk at Cairns Street to the proposed underpass connecting to the Kangaroo Point Green Bridge at Deakin Street.

The study is expected to be completed by March 2023. Public consultation on the options will be undertaken in early 2023.
