MR R STEVENS asked the Deputy Premier and Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympics Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise the costs associated to develop the State Infrastructure Strategy?

ANSWER:

Two contracts with values of \$158,000 and \$219,934 were associated with the State Infrastructure Strategy (SIS), noting these contracts also included work on the Queensland Government Infrastructure Pipeline (QGIP) and Regional Infrastructure Plans (RIPs).

These contracts are listed on the Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning Contract Disclosure (April-June 2021), which can be accessed via the Queensland Government Open Data Portal.

Further to this, as a part of engaging across Queensland to ensure the SIS and RIPs are informed by the views of Queenslanders, the department hosted 13 regional workshops across the state. Expenditure associated with this included approximately \$15,000 (excl. GST) for travel costs, venue hire etc.

The Palaszczuk Government is continuing to build the infrastructure our state needs with a \$59.1 billion infrastructure investment over the next four years to create local jobs, expand economic opportunities and deliver for Queenslanders.
