MR LAST ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND
MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of Traffic Infringement Notices (TINs) issued for the last three financial years (reported separately by year) with a breakdown of how many TINs were issued directly to the vehicle operator by Police and how many were issued due to the Camera Detected Offence Program?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that during the 2019-22 financial years, the number of infringement notices issued by the QPS was 3,052,013. The breakdown by financial year and method of issue is detailed in the table below.

2020/21	257,956	923,635	1,181,591
2021/22*	277,791	511,182	788,973

Note: CDOP data is extracted from live systems and subject to change.

The QPS advise that the data for the 2021/22 financial year includes CDOP data for the period 1 July 2021 to 31 January 2022 only. From 1 February 2022, authority to issue infringement notices for camera detected red light and speeding offences transitioned from the QPS to the Queensland Revenue Office. All other data is for the full financial year.
