MR T NICHOLLS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise (a) how many OLGR permanent FTE staff are currently based at the Gold Coast and (b) how many positions are vacant?

ANSWER:

I am advised that the Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation (OLGR) has two offices based at the Gold Coast. The Southport Office predominantly undertakes liquor compliance and has 10 Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs), with one vacancy. The vacant position will be filled shortly.

The OLGR Casino Inspectorate based at The Star Gold Coast predominantly undertakes casino and pub and club gaming compliance and has seven FTEs, with no vacancies.
