MS S BOLTON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)

QUESTION:

With reference to the response to Question on Notice No. 20 for the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee Estimates hearings, as part of disaster management—

Will the Minister outline what will be implemented by QFES or QPS to ensure that the information and data produced by DTMR's early alert monitors on bridges and crossings, will be provided in real time to alert the public via agencies and multiple channels including common consumer mapping products i.e. Google Maps?

ANSWER:

I am advised by Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) that any appropriate information or data provided to QFES through the governance of the Disaster Management Data Coordination Framework, can be shared in real time through the State Disaster Coordination Centre and the Situational Awareness Platform located within the QFES owned ArcGIS Online QDMA Data Sharing Group, which is accessible by all members within the Queensland Disaster Management Arrangements.

There would also be an opportunity for local councils to display this data within their online Disaster Dashboards contributing to real time public awareness.

I am advised by QFES that the early alert monitors on bridges and crossings come under the responsibility of the Department of Transport and Main Roads. As such, questions relating to this system should be directed to the relevant Minister.
