# QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise the number of allegations of corrupt conduct, or breaches of the Code of Conduct for the Queensland Public Service involving a departmental employee (reported separately for 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22)?

### ANSWER:

The Department of the Premier and Cabinet reports on conduct and performance matters that are categorised as Category 2, 3(a) and 3(b) of the Conduct and Performance Excellence case categorisation framework to the Public Service Commission (PSC), who publish this data for Queensland Government agencies annually.
