

**Question on Notice**

**Asked on 17 August 2022**

**Mr R Katter** asked Premier and Minister for the Olympics (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Premier's answer to a Question Without Notice on 23 October 2019 (Record of Proceeding Page 3520-3521), in which the Premier indicated that she would find out the full cost to defend against allegations regarding the threat to withdraw and ultimate withdrawal of KAP resources—

Will the Premier advise (a) if the Premier discharged her undertaking to find out the full cost of the legal defence in this matter, (b) if the Premier has ever reported the full cost of the legal defence to the House or the public and (c) what was the full cost of this legal defence to Queensland taxpayers?

ANSWER:

As outlined in Hansard, the question was not taken on notice pursuant to the Standing Orders. The quantum relating to legal indemnity and assistance is not routinely published, a practice which has occurred under successive governments. I can advise the Member again that the indemnity and grant of legal assistance was in line with the guidelines.
