MR R STEVENS ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TOURISM, INNOVATION AND SPORT AND MINISTER ASSISTING THE PREMIER ON OLYMPICS AND PARALYMPICS SPORT AND ENGAGEMENT (HON S HINCHLIFFE) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the Director General's testimony at the recent Estimates hearing that there will be one section of the Wangetti Trail where the hiking trail will be separated from the mountain bikes—

Will the Minister provide the precise start and end point of this separated section?

ANSWER:

The Wangetti North section of the Wangetti Trail, which extends from Wangetti township to the Mowbray River, may, subject to environmental approvals, constructability and market and industry advice, utilise existing backcountry roads in the Macalister Range National Park to separate mountain bikes from hikers. This potential mountain bike link was released for public comment in 2019 and would start at the Captain Cook Highway in the Wangetti township and reconnect at Twin Bridges Track.
