**MR T MANDER** ASKED MINISTER FOR ENERGY, RENEWABLES AND HYDROGEN AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND PROCUREMENT (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to corrupt conduct, or misconduct by Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) employees—

Will the Minister provide (a) the position of the staff member dismissed following a Crime and Corruption Commission investigation, (b) the number of staff with open investigations stemming from misconduct, (c) the number of QBCC staff currently suspended with pay, (d) the dollar value of payments made to staff since being stood down with full pay and (e) the number of staff suspended without pay?

**ANSWER**

The information privacy principles place strict obligations on agencies and prevent me from disclosing identifiable information in the form of a role or position description concerning any staff member that may have been dismissed from the Queensland Building and Construction Commission (QBCC) and was subject to Crime and Corruption Commission (CCC) review and monitoring.

In terms of the number of staff that have open investigations against them, or are currently suspended either with or without pay, it would not be appropriate to discuss any specific matters that are currently undergoing assessment or investigation by the QBCC and/or may be subject to CCC review and monitoring.
