MR B MICKELBERG ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

## **QUESTION**

With reference to Question on Notice No. 268 of 2022, given that mid-year performance reviews were four months overdue when the response was tabled on 28 April 2022 and full year performance reviews were due 30 June 2022—Will the Minister provide an update on the current performance levels of each hospital and health service?

#### **ANSWER**

I am advised that the Hospital and Health Service (HHS) performance levels as at the 2021-22 mid-year review (latest performance levels) are as follows:

Due to the reporting cycles and when data is available, quarterly performance meetings are usually scheduled for six to eight weeks after the quarter has ended to ensure data accuracy and robust discussions.

Due to the height of the COVID pandemic, the last two quarters official performance meetings have been delayed, however the Department of Health continues to meet with representatives from the HHSs to discuss performance issues and offer assistance if required.

Quarter One performance meetings for 2022-23 are expected to revert to normal reporting scheduling.
