QUESTION:

With reference to each public school in the Southport Electorate—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by school) (a) the number of term 3 enrolments at each school, (b) the maximum student capacity for each school and (c) what percentage of students represent out-of-catchment enrolments?

ANSWER:

Enrolments, capacity and out-of-catchment data for state schools located in the Southport Electorate are detailed in the table below.
