MS S BOLTON ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND MINISTER FOR THE PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON S FENTIMAN) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Answer to Question on Notice No. 19 in the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee Estimates hearings —

Will the Attorney-General confirm that the Coaldrake Review Implementation Taskforce will undertake a cooperative ‘co-design’ process with the relevant Parliamentary Committees in implementing recommendation 12 of the Coaldrake Report regarding independence of integrity bodies, and what this will entail?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Noosa for her question.

In my response to Estimates QON 19, I advised the Member that the Palaszczuk Government is committed to implementing the recommendations of Professor Peter Coaldrake’s, *Let the Sunshine In: Review of culture and accountability in the Queensland Public Sector Final Report*.

I can also advise the Coaldrake Review Implementation Taskforce has been established under the Department of the Premier and Cabinet and as such I direct the Member to the Premier and Minister for the Olympics.
