Will the Minister advise the number of allegations of corrupt conduct or breaches of the Code of Conduct for the Queensland Public Service involving a departmental employee that were recorded in 2019–20, 2020–21 and 2021–22 (reported separately by year)?

The Crime and Corruption Commission publishes data about allegations of corrupt conduct made against Queensland Government agencies, including the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) online at www.ccc.qld.gov.au/corruption/corruption-allegations-data-dashboard.

TMR reports on conduct and performance matters that are categorised as Category 2, 3(a) and 3(b) of the Conduct and Performance Excellence case categorisation framework to the Public Service Commission (PSC), which publishes this data for Queensland Government agencies annually. This data is available online at www.forgov.qld.gov.au/human-resources/employee-management-conduct-and-performance/conduct-and-performance/conduct-and-performance-data. I am further advised by the PSC that the 2021–22 data will be published by 30 September 2022.
