MS A CAMM ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the road death toll data for the Mackay/Whitsunday Region (reported separately by year from 2015-2021) including incident type (single vehicle accident vs multi-vehicle crash) and breakdown between Bruce Highway vs Peak Downs Highway?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the number of lives lost on roads in the Mackay Whitsunday Police District for the years 2015 to 2021 is detailed in the table below:

Number of fatalities by units involved and road, Mackay Whitsunday District, 1 January 2015 to 31 December 2021

2. Data relates to occurrences in Mackay Whitsunday District with a 1406 Traffic Crash - Fatal Incident and is in scope.
3. Number of fatalities refer to the number of person MVC reports where the injury severity is 'dead'.
4. A single vehicle accident refers to a traffic crash where only one unit was involved.
5. Multi-vehicle crash refers to a traffic crash where more than one unit was involved.
