MS S BOLTON ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Minister's response provided in the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee Estimates hearing—

Will the Minister clarify what progress has been made in the ICT system integration for the sharing of essential enforcement and infringement information between the Queensland Police Service, Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service and Marine Safety Queensland?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that there are no current or projected plans for interagency ICT systems integration.

I am further advised by the QPS that, as per the response to Question on Notice 279 tabled on 23 March 2021, where legally permissible, information and intelligence is shared between agencies and the QPS will continue to collaborate with its external partners to enhance community safety.
