MR J KRAUSE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide comparative traffic volume data (number of vehicles and type if available) for vehicles travelling through Canungra on Beaudesert Nerang Road, based on traffic counts undertaken by the department where possible, between 2012 and 2022?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Scenic Rim for the question.

Traffic volume data for Beaudesert–Nerang Road through Canungra from 2012 to 2021 is provided in the table below. Traffic data for 2022 is currently being collected and this data will be available early 2023.
