Question on Notice No. 981 Asked on 12 October 2022

MR J LANGBROEK ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise how many penalty infringement notices have been issued in the last three years for Motorised Mobility Devices (MMDs) and Personalised Mobility Devices (PMDs) for exceeding the speed limit on public infrastructure in Queensland (reported separately by region)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that while the QPS does not record the number of infringements for exceeding the speed limit on public infrastructure, the QPS does records the number of infringements relating to exceeding speed where there is a speed limit imposed.

However, the QPS has also advised that to provide the number of infringements for speeding on MMDs would require a manual examination of a large number of individual infringement notice records and this is considered an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.

That being said, I am advised by the QPS that the number of infringements for exceeding 25 km/h on a PMD for the last three years to 30 June 2022 is detailed in the table below:
