MS R BATES ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to Emergency Departments in Queensland's 26 largest reporting hospitals—

Will the Minister advise how many patients were in hospital Emergency Departments for more than 24 hours before being discharged or admitted as an inpatient (reported separately by each hospital and each calendar month) from June to September 2022?

ANSWER

A patient may stay for 24 hours within the ED for a number of reasons. This may include patients with volatile clinical status requiring repeated adjustments to treatment interventions and clinical decision making around ongoing care needs and most appropriate disposition. There may be other factors including the requirement for a specific type of bed for example telemetry, negative pressure, isolation or mental health.

When patients do wait in the ED for more than 24 hours, they are monitored by the clinical staff and the management to identify the reason and to take affirmative action where required. For example if a patient is waiting for a medical admission then an escalation process will occur to help facilitate the movement of the patient.

I have been advised by the department that the below lists the number of patients that were in hospital Emergency Departments for more than 24 hours before being discharged or admitted from the months of June to September 2022.
