MR A POWELL ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON Y D'ATH)—

QUESTION

With reference to where demands for compensation have been made by a third party against Queensland Health—

Will the Minister provide (reported separately for each calendar year from 2017 to date) (a) the total value of compensation afforded to third parties by Queensland Health through the Queensland Government Insurance Fund and (b) the number of non-disclosure agreements entered into with third parties who have successfully made a claim against Queensland Health and received compensation through the Queensland Government Insurance Fund?

ANSWER

I am advised that the Queensland Government Insurance Fund, and therefore all claim settlement details, are the responsibility of the Treasury portfolio as the delegated authority and decision maker on all insured claims.
