# MR T MANDER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING (HON M SCANLON)—

# QUESTION:

With reference to the 648 'existing properties' purchased by the Department of Housing since 2015-16, confirmed by the Director-General at the Estimates Hearing of the Community Support and Services Committee—

Will the Minister provide the number of properties purchased each financial year (reported separately by Housing Service Centre)?

#### ANSWER:

Bayside Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, four dwellings; in 2016-17, one dwelling; in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, two dwellings.

Bundaberg Housing Service Centre: in 2020-21, one dwelling; in 2021-22, two dwellings; and in 2022-23, one dwelling.

Buranda Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, three dwellings; in 2016-17, six dwellings; and in 2022-23, two dwellings.

Cairns Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, 22 dwellings; in 2016-17, two dwellings; in 2017-18, two dwellings; in 2020-21, three dwellings; in 2021-22, three dwellings; and in 2022-23, 13 dwellings.

Chermside Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, two dwellings; in 2016-17, 24 dwellings; in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, two dwellings.

Emerald Housing Service Centre: in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, four dwellings.

Fortitude Valley Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, two dwellings; in 2021-22, three dwellings; and in 2022-23, 70 dwellings.

Gladstone Housing Service Centre: in 2020-21, one dwelling; in 2021-22, six dwellings; and in 2022-23, 35 dwellings.

Gold Coast Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, five dwellings; in 2016-17, three dwellings; in 2019-20, one dwelling; in 2021-22, nine dwellings; and in 2022-23, four dwellings.

Inala Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, two dwellings; in 2016-17, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, six dwellings.

Ipswich Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, nine dwellings; in 2016-17, eight dwellings; in 2017-18, nine dwellings; in 2018-19, one dwelling; in 2020-21, one dwelling; in 2021-22, 12 dwellings; and in 2022-23, 19 dwellings.

Logan Housing Service Centre: in 2016-17, 13 dwellings, in 2021-22; one dwelling and in 2022-23; 27 dwellings.

Mackay Housing Service Centre: in 2021-22, seven dwellings; and in 2022-23, 15 dwellings.

Maroochydore Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, five dwellings; in 2016-17, three dwellings; in 2017-18, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, seven dwellings.

Maryborough Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, seven dwellings; in 2016-17, two dwellings, in 2017-18; one dwelling, in 2018-19; one dwelling, in 2020-21; one dwelling, in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, 12 dwellings.

Moreton Bay Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, 10 dwellings; in 2016-17, nine dwellings; in 2017-18, one dwelling; in 2019-20, two dwellings; in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, 16 dwellings.

Mount Isa Housing Service Centre: in 2022-23, the department purchased one dwelling.

Rockhampton Housing Service Centre: in 2021-22, one dwelling; and in 2022-23, three dwellings.

Toowoomba Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, six dwellings; in 2016-17, two dwellings; in 2018-19, two dwellings; in 2019-20, one dwelling; in 2020-21, two dwellings, in 2021-22; eight dwellings; and in 2022-23, 72 dwellings.

Townsville Housing Service Centre: in 2015-16, 16 dwellings; in 2016-17, six dwellings; in 2020-21, one dwelling; in 2021-22, 13 dwellings; and in 2022-23, 62 dwellings.
