MR J LANGBROEK ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

QUESTION

With reference to the \$250,000 per annum provided for the Safe and Diverse Communities grants program to support targeted community-led projects towards improving women's safety in CALD communities across Queensland—

Will the Minister advise (a) details of the programs and (b) where the programs will be delivered?

ANSWER

The Safe and Diverse Communities Grant Program supports small, targeted, community-led projects to increase the capability of multicultural communities to recognise, respond and prevent sexual, domestic and family violence across Queensland. It is administered through the Department of Justice and Attorney-General.

As a result questions regarding the allocation of those funds should be redirected to the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence.
