

## **Question on Notice**

**No. 1037**

**Asked on 12 September 2023**

**MR R KATTER** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

### **QUESTION:**

With reference to the first two rounds of the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund—

Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) how much was paid into the fund per round by (i) the Queensland Government and (ii) liable resource companies and (b) how much was paid out of the fund per round, and per Local Government Area?

### **ANSWER:**

The first two rounds of the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund (the Fund) made funding of \$100 million available, with coal and mineral resource companies volunteering to contribute \$70 million and the State contributing \$30 million.

Contributions to the Fund were not linked to the timing of Round 1 and 2 allocations. Contributions as of 20 September 2023 total \$30 million from the Queensland Government and \$69.6 million from coal and mineral resource companies.

- Mackay Regional – \$6.2 million
- Mapoon Aboriginal Shire –\$2.9 million
- McKinlay Shire –\$6.3 million
- Mount Isa City –\$11.9 million
- Rockhampton Regional –\$2.5 million
- Townsville City –\$0.3 million
- Weipa Town – \$3.3 million
- Whitsunday Regional – \$2.6 million
- Woorabinda Aboriginal Shire – \$1.7 million
