MR J SULLIVAN ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the total infrastructure investment in the Stafford Electorate State Schools since 2015 and the total infrastructure investment between 2012 and 2015 (reported separately by each state school) and also include schools bordering the electorate with catchments covering the Stafford Electorate, such as Everton Park SHS, Craigslea SHS and Kedron SHS?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education is committed to building and maintaining fit-for-purpose learning environments that support educational outcomes.

Since 2015, the department has invested \$59.2 million (including GST) in building and maintaining education infrastructure at state schools in the Stafford Electorate, including a planned investment of \$13.8 million (including GST) in 2023–24.

Between 2012 and 2015, the department invested \$17 million (including GST) in building and maintaining education infrastructure at state schools in the Stafford Electorate.
