MR R MOLHOEK ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING (HON M SCANLON)—

# QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) how many children and young people (reported separately by age group and region) are currently cared for in Youth Foyers across Queensland and (b) what the annual average cost of care was per person in Youth Foyers for the 2022-23 financial year?

## ANSWER:

Queensland currently has two Youth Foyers, located in Logan and at the Gold Coast, with the third Youth Foyer under construction in Townsville due to open in 2024.

As at 14 September 2023, the Logan Youth Foyer was accommodating a total of 39 young people, with 10 tenants under 18 years and 29 tenants aged 18 years or older.

As at 14 September 2023, the Gold Coast Youth Foyer was accommodating a total of 38 young people, with two tenants aged under 18 years and 36 tenants aged 18 years or older.

The annual average cost of support per person in Youth Foyers in 2022-23 was approximately \$25,325.
