QUESTION:

With reference to the advice provided by the Premier that no briefing notes have been provided regarding non-compliance with the Queensland Ministerial Handbook (Question on Notice No. 505 asked on 9 May 2023)—

Will the Premier (a) advise if advice has been provided in any other format (including verbal) and (b) provide details of these briefings?

ANSWER:

As outlined in my response to Question on Notice No. 505 asked on 9 May 2023, I am advised that regular meetings occur between the Premier's Office and the Department of the Premier and Cabinet regarding ministerial services matters, including the Ministerial Handbook which provides guidance to all Ministers, Assistant Ministers and staff on the operations of their offices.

Any matters of alleged non-compliance with elements of the Ministerial Handbook are dealt with by the appropriate officer.
