Mr R Katter asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier outline, in total and based on 2023 estimates, how much public money the Queensland Government expects will be spent on the hosting costs to stage the 2032 Brisbane Olympic Games?

ANSWER:

The Organising Committee for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games is responsible for staging the Games in 2032. The budget for the Organising Committee will be fully funded from contributions by the International Olympic Committee and their own revenue sources such as sponsorship, ticket sales, merchandising and the like.

In addition, all three levels of government will be required to provide services that will assist in the successful and safe delivery of the Games. This includes things such as public safety, health and ambulance services, and transport services. The final costs will be reconciled at the end of the Games.
