Question on Notice No. 1116 Asked on 14 September 2023

Ms F Simpson asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Coaldrake Report's recommendation for a complaints clearing house—

Will the Premier advise (a) all options considered, (b) the cost for each and (c) why each option was not viable for implementation?

ANSWER:

As announced on 18 September 2023, our Government will implement the clearing house in conjunction with other enhanced integrity measures.

An independent, eminent person will lead this work. They will also prioritise serious and complex complaints and chair an oversight board made up of key integrity bodies.

This model is different to the one previously considered by Government, which are subject to Cabinet-in-Confidence provisions.

I am advised that the eminent person and board will be in place and will meet this year.
