Mr J Bleijie asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Premier's commitment at Estimates to bring forward construction of the Olympic and Paralympic Games athlete villages to be used as short-term accommodation before 2032—

Will the Premier provide (a) the cost to convert the short-term accommodation to athlete accommodation prior to the Games, (b) the cost to convert the athlete accommodation to its post-Games configuration and (c) the government's plans for housing short-term residents once they are removed so the accommodation can be used for the Games?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government is currently reviewing opportunities with relevant stakeholders to bring forward construction of the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games athlete villages. Potential cost impacts and identification of potential users of accommodation prior to the Games have yet to be identified.
