Mr A Powell asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Events Sponsorship Fund—

Will the Premier advise (a) to date, how much of the fund has been allocated to recipients for 2023-24, 2024-25 and 2025-26 (reported separately) and (b) who are the approved recipients to date?

ANSWER:

- (a) I am advised by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet that as at 10 October 2023, the Events Sponsorship Fund (ESF) has allocated:
- \$2,750,800 (excluding GST) in sponsorship funding for the 2023-24 financial year
 - \$455,000 (excluding GST) in sponsorship funding for the 2024-25 financial year, and
 - \$320,000 (excluding GST) in sponsorship funding for the 2025-26 financial year.
- (b) I am advised by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet that as at 10 October 2023, funding has been committed in 2023-2026 to the following recipients:
