MR R STEVENS ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the high visibility police patrols conducted under Operation Victor Unison— Will the Minister advise the time an activity must be undertaken for it to count as a high visibility patrol or activity?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that there is no time limitation applied to an officer conducting a high visibility patrol.

All proactive activities (encompassing high visibility patrols) and associated hours are recorded against Operation Victor Unison. I am advised by QPS that as at 16 October 2023, there were approximately 107,700 proactive activities conducted over approximately 40,900 hours.
