MR D CRISAFULLI ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the number of RBT tests undertaken and traffic infringement notices issued each year for the last six calendar years (reported separately by police district)?

ANSWER:

- 1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
- 2. RBT data has been sourced from the Intelligence, Tactical and Analysis System (ITAS).
- 3. RBT data for districts is based on the district where the RBT was taken, not the organisational unit of the officer performing the RBT.
- 4. RBT data has been derived from RBTs with a valid X, Y coordinate. Tests that cannot be attributed to a district have been excluded.
- 5. TIN data has been sourced from QPRIME and may differ from other sources relating to traffic infringements.
- 6. TIN infringement data refers to offence code 1465.
- 7. TIN data for districts refers to the location of the offence, not the issuing organisational unit.
- 8. TIN data excludes infringements issued as paper tickets.
