MR M BOOTHMAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES
AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the number of Queensland Police Officers on leave that are currently serving in Police Services/Forces in other Australian State or federal jurisdictions and New Zealand (in table format, reported separately by calendar year) from 2015 to date?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that arrangements for QPS personnel who are seconded, or take leave without pay, to work with police jurisdictions other than the QPS, are typically managed on a case-by-case basis.

I am further advised by the QPS that to provide a definitive answer to the question requires a manual review and interrogation of the Aurion Human Resource Information System which would then need to be reconciled against other sources, which is considered by the QPS to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
