Ms F Simpson asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the department's strategic review undertaken by Deloitte in 2021—

Will the Premier advise (a) the number of Associate Directors-General currently in the department, (b) the pay band of each of the positions and (c) if the projected benefits from the addition of these positions forecast in the strategic review have been realised (including any metrics used to measure the effectiveness)?

ANSWER:

The Department of the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) currently has two Associate Director-General roles.

Remuneration information for these roles is included in DPC's most recent annual report tabled in the Legislative Assembly (2022-2023 available on page 92 following the link below), which also provides an overview of DPC's performance throughout the report.
