MR A PERRETT ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the land for the new Gympie Fire and Rescue station that was purchased in 2014—

Will the Minister advise the construction timeline for a new station?

ANSWER:

In 2023-24 Budget Paper 3, \$2.4 million has been committed to continue the construction of the Gympie South Fire and Rescue Station (FRS). This project has a total budget of \$7.5 million and I am advised by Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) that the planning and concept design stage is well advanced.

I am further advised by QFES that the Gympie South FRS is indicatively scheduled for construction during the next financial year (2024-25) and will be dependent on normal construction timeframes and any weather and/or labour market considerations.
