Dr A MacMahon asked Premier and Minister for the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Hon. A Palaszczuk)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise since January 2020, how many export licences or permits for military, defence or dual-use goods exports have been issued in Queensland for equipment bound for the (a) State of Israel, (b) Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, (c) Republic of the Philippines, (d) Republic of Indonesia, (e) Republic of India, (f) French Republic, (g) United Arab Emirates, (h) United States of America?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet that the Department of Defence regulates the export and supply of military and dual-use goods and technologies. Consequently, the Member may wish to contact the responsible Federal Government ministers.
