MR M BOOTHMAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Rural Fire Brigade—

Will the Minister advise the age of individual appliance vehicles (including unit number) for each brigade across Gold Coast, Logan, Ipswich and Scenic Rim (in table format)?

ANSWER:

This government is investing in a \$123 Million pipeline for 412 new and replacement Rural Fire Service vehicles.

This is in addition to the 413 appliances already delivered by this government since 2015.

Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) advises that 16 of the below Rural Fire Brigades (RFB) are due to have their appliance replaced in the next 18 months.

I am advised by QFES that there are examples in the below list where despite new appliances being offered to brigades in prior years, they have elected to retain their vehicle.

Notwithstanding this, QFES advises that rural fire brigades can only elect to retain their appliance for up to 30 years, providing the vehicle has an annual Safety Inspection, Safety Certificate or a Certificate of Inspection provided by a qualified mechanic.

Further, I am advised that the age of the appliance is not always the best indicator of the need for the appliance to be replaced as QFES takes a range of factors into account when determining the need to replace an appliance, including overall condition, service history and the number of kilometres travelled.
