MR J LANGBROEK asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the answer to Question on Notice No. 1155 of 2023, the Indigenous Councils Critical Infrastructure program, and specifically the projects still on Milestone 1 in Aurukun, Doomadgee, Kowanyama and the Northern Peninsula Area—Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) what assistance the department has provided each of these councils to expedite the projects and (b) what are the projected dates of these projects to move to milestone 2 and milestone 3?

ANSWER:

All projects in Aurukun Shire Council have been delivered, the Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning is working with the council to review finalisation documentation to progress to Milestone 3.

The Department is supporting Kowanyama Aboriginal Shire Council in delivering its project with completion expected by December 2023. Once completed, the project finalisation documentation will be submitted for the department to review and to progress projects to Milestone 3.

At the request of the councils, the department is managing the delivery of the ICCIP projects for Doomadgee Aboriginal Shire Council and Northern Peninsula Area Regional Council. All remaining projects are expected to be completed in 2024.
