MS A LEAHY asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Betterment funding jointly-funded by the Queensland and Australian governments under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements—
Will the Deputy Premier advise the current allocation from 2022-23 to 2026-27 (reported separately by financial year)?

ANSWER:

Three Betterment Fund programs totalling \$190 million are currently in delivery across Queensland to improve the disaster resilience of essential public assets damaged through natural disaster events.

The expenditure for these Betterment Funds will be incurred progressively as the works are delivered and acquitted. The balance of the Betterment Fund programs is currently allocated across financial years as follows: 2022-23 \$24.9 million; 2023-24 \$83.4 million; 2024-25 \$72.0 million; 2025-26 \$9.6 million.
