Will the Minister provide the number of Queensland Rail drivers (reported separately by current age)?

ANSWER:

Queensland Rail continues to maintain an adequate supply of drivers to deliver reliable services across Queensland.

The ages of all Queensland Rail drivers on both its South East Queensland and Regional networks are as follow:

- 25–29 years old = 17
- 30–34 years old = 56
- 35–39 years old = 113
- 40–44 years old = 135
- 45–49 years old = 101
- 50–54 years old = 110
- 55–59 years old = 122
- 60–64 years old = 77
- 65 years old and over = 40.
