MR R STEVENS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

With reference to the Youth Justice Act—

Will the Attorney-General advise (reported separately by year) for the last five years (a) how many parents of young offenders have been ordered by a court to pay compensation, and (b) the total amount of orders for compensation?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for their question.

I am advised that, for the years 2018-19 to 2022-23, the number of parents of young offenders ordered to pay compensation was zero. For the year 2023-24 (to 31 October 2023), the number of parents of young offenders ordered to pay compensation was one.

I am further advised that the total amount of orders for parents of a young offender to pay compensation was \$119.63.
