MR S ANDREW ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

With reference to regional communities being hit with unprecedented levels of speeding fines from cameras sited in contravention of 6.3.2 of the state's Traffic Manual Guidelines—

Will the Minister (a) review the use of private contractors for siting of these devices in illegal areas and (b) provide citizens with full refunds for the fines incurred from illegally sited speed traps?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that it does not use private contractors for enforcement activities.

I am further advised that the QPS and its employees follows the guidelines contained within the Traffic Manual including the positioning of speed detection devices.

The answer to part (b) of the question is the responsibility of Minister Mark Bailey as the minister responsible for the Department of Transport and Main Roads. I recommend that the Member direct this portion of the question to the responsible minister.
