MR J MCDONALD asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Minister Assisting the Premier on Olympic and Paralympic Games Infrastructure (HON S MILES) –

# QUESTION:

With reference to the \$150m Catalyst Infrastructure Fund—Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) the actual expenditure for 2022-23, (b) the allocated expenditure to date for 2023-24 to 2027-28 (reported separately by financial year) and (c) the current full list of funding recipients?

#### ANSWER:

# (a) and (b)

As indicated in the response to Question on Notice 1218, tabled on 10 November 2023, expenditure of the \$150m Catalyst Infrastructure Fund (CIF) is subject to successful negotiation with proponents and execution of infrastructure agreements. As indicated in the response to Question on Notice 1218, it is expected that the full CIF of \$150 million will be allocated by June 2024.

(c) The list of proponents currently negotiating infrastructure agreements remains confidential until the infrastructure agreements are executed by the Minister for Economic Development Queensland.
