DR A MACMAHON ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION, MINISTER FOR INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS AND MINISTER FOR RACING (HON G GRACE)

QUESTION:

With reference to the Greater Brisbane Greyhound Centre—

Will the Minister advise (a) what was the state government funding committed for the Greater Brisbane Greyhound Centre, when announced by the Minister September 2022 and (b) what is the current expected state government funding for the Centre, as of 28 November 2023?

ANSWER:

On 18 October 2019, the then Minister for Local Government, Minister for Racing and Minister for Multicultural Affairs announced \$39.15 million from the Queensland Government's Racing Infrastructure Fund (RIF) for the Greater Brisbane Greyhound Centre, now known as The Q. The RIF is predominately made up of funds from Tabcorp's exclusive wagering agreement with Queensland.

On 8 September 2022, I announced the new venue had received development approval and provided more details about the facilities that would be delivered through the project. The announcement reaffirmed the project would receive \$39.15 million from the RIF.

As of 28 November 2023, the Government's commitment of \$39.15 million from the RIF towards this project remains unchanged.
