**MR S KNUTH** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON M BAILEY)—

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the answer to Question on Notice No. 1304 of 2023—

Will the Minister advise, for the past five years, details of any speed related car crashes that have occurred in the exact section of the Malanda/Atherton Road from the 60km/h to the 80 km/h zone, where a speed camera device was stationed from 7-21 September 2023?

I thank the Member for Hill for the question.

On 18 December 2023, I was appointed as Minister for Transport and Main Roads and Minister for Digital Services and, as such, I am now the responsible Minister to answer this Question.

For the section of Malanda–Atherton Road, Malanda, between Downing Street and Upper Baron Road, there has been one speed-related casualty crash reported to police. This crash resulted in one person being transported to hospital. There were no fatalities. This data is current from 1 January 2018 to 31 July 2023 for fatal crashes. For non-fatal crashes, the data is current from 1 January 2018 and 28 February 2023.

There have, however, been four other speed-related casualty crashes on Malanda–Atherton Road within 2.5 kilometres either side of the speed camera site.
