MR J LANGBROEK ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND CORRECTIVE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON M RYAN)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise, for speeding fines issued to users of Personal Mobility Devices (PMDs) across Queensland since November 2022 (reported separately by region) (a) the number of people fined, (b) the quantum of fine and (c) the category of infringement?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) in relation to the Member's question, for the period 1 November 2022 to 30 November 2023, as follows:

- (a) That 247 people have been issued fines for speeding on a Personal Mobility Device (PMD) in Brisbane Police Region, six in Central Police Region, 17 in Far Northern Police Region, 32 in North Coast Police Region, seven in Northern Police Region, 11 in South Eastern Police Region, and 34 in Southern Police Region.

2. Data refers to the number of persons issued with an infringement notice between 1 November 2022 and 30 November 2023 for PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14 km/h (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by less than 14kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath), and PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by more than 30kmh.
3. Persons is a unique person count. A person with more than one infringement notice issued will be counted once in each category.

- (b) That the quantum of fines issued in Brisbane Police Region was \$70,311, in Central Police Region was \$2,496, in Far Northern Police Region was \$8,934, in North Coast Police Region was \$18,613, in Northern Police Region was \$4,336, in South Eastern Police Region was \$6,537, and in Southern Police Region was \$17,778.

3. Amount of fines is based on data as recorded in QPRIME and may include infringements that have been waived or cancelled.

- (c) That the infringements issued for exceeding the speed limit on a PMD relate to the infringement categories of:

For Brisbane Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by less than 14kmh, PMD

exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh, and PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath).

For Central Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), and PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath).

For Far Northern Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by less than 14kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh, and PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath).

For Northern Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, and PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath).

For South Eastern Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by less than 14kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), and PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath).

For Southern Police Region, PMD exceed speed limit by less than 14kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by less than 14kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 14kmh to 20kmh, PMD exceed speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh (not footpath), PMD exceed 12kmh footpath speed limit by 20kmh to 30kmh, and PMD exceed speed limit by more than 30kmh (not footpath).
