**MR R MOLHOEK** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TREATY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS, MINISTER FOR COMMUNITIES AND MINISTER FOR THE ARTS (HON L ENOCH)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise the number of apprentices and trainees directly employed by the Department of Treaty, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Communities and the Arts as at 30 September 2023 (reported separately by vocational qualification)?

**ANSWER:**

In relation to the Department of Treaty, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Communities and the Arts (the department), I am advised that as of 30 September 2023 employs 132 (17.35%) First Nations staff, three of which are digital trainees directly employed by the department.

Trainees directly employed by DTATSIPCA are currently undertaking Cert III and Cert IV training in Information Technology and Business.
