**DR M ROBINSON** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Redland Housing Strategy—

Will the Minister provide location details for the construction of social housing complexes to accommodate people in need?

ANSWER:

The *Draft Redland Housing Strategy (2023 – 2046)* recognises the role social and affordable housing play in providing housing choice for the community but does not specifically identify locations of projects.

Since 2015, the Queensland Government has committed a record \$5 billion investment in social and affordable housing supply. Through this investment, along with the \$398.3 million investment from the Albanese Government, the Queensland Government will support the commencement of at least 14,100 social and affordable homes by mid-2027. Since coming to Government in 2015, the Queensland Government has delivered new social homes across Dunwich, Capalaba, Thornlands, Cleveland, Alexandra Hills, Birkdale, Victoria Point and Wellington Point.

In total there are 108 social homes in the Redlands region as at 30 November 2023 with more to come.
